Dear Sir:

Enclosed please find a supplement to Technical Specification Change Request No. 152 which adds an additional change to the Cycle Seven Technical Specifications (submitted April 15, 1987). This change modifies the design description of Technical Specification 5.3.2, Control Rods, to reflect the use of new control rods for Cycle Seven. The new rod design was discussed in our original submittal and in our July 17, 1987 submittal responding to NRC questions. This supplement provides additional information on the new control rods and provides a revised Technical Specification page.

Enclosed is a revised Sholly Evaluation, as requested by the Staff. This evaluation replaces the previous evaluation and addresses both Technical Specification Change No. 152 and this Supplement.

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Due to a shorter Cycle Six than anticipated, Cycle Seven parameters will be different from those provided in the Reload Report. The Reload Report was based on a Cycle Six length of 465 (plus or minus 10) Effective Full Power Days (EFPDs). Actual Cycle Six length will be between 405 and 410 EFPDs. Florida Power is currently reanalyzing the Cycle Seven physics parameters to confirm that existing operating and accident analyses are still valid and is expecting to complete these analyses around October 9th. A description of the changes and any impact to Technical Specifications and accident analyses will be provided to the Staff upon completing the analyses. Preliminary analyses indicate that new Technical Specification changes and new accident analyses will not be needed.

An amendment application fee was submitted with our April 15, 1987 submittal and so is not included with this Supplement.
