

Dr. Glenn Seaborg, Chairman Atomic Energy Commission Washington 25, D.C.

Dear Dr. Seaborg:

We feel that the P.G.& E.Co. should not be granted permission to build a nuclear plant at Bodega Head, for the following reasons:

Because it would poison the daily living of people with fear of disaster. This could go on for years and years...indefinitely. A psychological burden of this sort could be as harmful as physical injury. No amount of soothing words can conceal the fact that a nuclear plant has potential dangers; nor can one forget the fact that earthquakes and their intensities are totally unpredictable. This installation would create, in our opinion, a most uncivilized situation for the people of Sonoma County.

And it would be unfortunate, we think, for a Governmental agency to take sides with a private monopoly against the wishes and the welfare of the Public. The question would undoubtedly arise in many minds:
"Where is our Democracy?"

There are alternatives to this site that do not involve the rights of human beings and other living creatures.

We urge your earnest consideration of the human side of this question.
