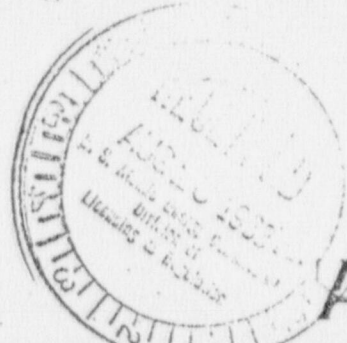
Political parties or "Political Party Politicians" should have no place in such a decision - the location of a facility - licensed by the Government for the benefit of the people of today and the future.
