Dear sir,

The violation of citizens right by our supervisors in refusing to have a public hearing on the Bodega Atomic reactor plant is of concern to one and all. Only the P. B. & E has been favored, though Mr. Bennett of P. U. C. has disagreed consistently - I've attended all the hearings to understand the situation better. All I've gleaned is that no wonder Justice wears a handkerchief over her eyes - ashamed to see what is going on, no doubt.

Mass evidence points to non-safety factors in the Bodega site - "Nuclear Information" for April 64 gives a good account of the site - by experts - if the A. E. C. must buy plutonium formed in these reactors, for heaven's sake put them where they won't endanger life and don't ram them down the throats of people.
