Scope

Russ Rentschler, NRC Team Leader, described the purpose of the meeting as follows:

1. Material Control and Security Assessment
2. Not an inspection although group findings and observations may be explored at a later date during formal I&E inspections.
3. Assessment of adequacy of licensee systems to meet current Regulatory requirements.
4. Observations and findings related to upgrading as may in the future be necessary as a result of GESMO or public comments on 10 CFR 73.55.

Basis

The basis against which judgments are made will be the hypothetical threat of (1) one trusted employee normally having access to SNM and (2) three armed individuals with military training and a knowledge of the facility one or more of that group may be an insider.
