If anything, the NRC should require PE to comply to the letter of all regulations, and the NRC should spot-check compliance on an un-announced basis. Further, we wish to register our concern that the present plan for the re-start of Peach Bottom (P.E.'s Commitment to Excellence plan) does not address the generic flaws of the reactor design, and in particular the deficient containment.
