SUBJECT: INVESTIGATION OF ALLEGED ELECTRICAL DEFICIENCIES AT
COMANCHE PEAK STEAM ELECTRIC STATION

Attached is the Office of Investigations' Report of Investigation concerning the above matter.

The investigation was initiated upon receipt of allegations by an electrician formerly employed at Comanche Peak. The allegations involved a number of problems, in the alleege's view, with the plant's electrical work which he had observed in 1979-1980. Several of his concerns were alleviated when he was shown documentation of inspections, reports, procedures and tests conducted after he left the construction site in January 1980. The remainder were made the subject of inspection effort which confirmed that the electrical work in question was done properly. No wrongdoing having been alleged and no electrical problems having been verified, this investigation is closed.

We have provided two copies of the Report of Investigation. In the first, names, significant identifying details, and interview statements (e.g. reports of interview, signed statements, verbatim transcripts) are included to enhance its usefulness to you. This version of the Report should not be disseminated outside your organization. In the second, for privacy reasons, we have eliminated this type of information. You may distribute this expurgated version as you deem appropriate.
