PHONE CONVERSATION WITH MR. ROBERT GIFFORD
OF GILBERT ASSOCIATES

Mr. Gifford called me to discuss the possibility of having a meeting concerning containment for the proposed Rochester Gas and Electric Plant. He stated that Gilbert Associates had been retained by General Atomics to work on this plant as architect-engineers. The exact relationship of the contractual arrangement was not discussed except that he stated that if the project were approved, Gilbert Associates would be the architect-engineers for the job.

I told him that we would be happy to meet with him at a mutually convenient time to discuss the containment for the proposed plant. I further mentioned to him that we had published a TID which contained many of our ideas about containment building requirements and that perhaps he should avail himself of this document to help him further with his problem. He stated that he would obtain the document and be in contact with me later about the proposed meeting.
