THE BODEGA BAY SITE WAS VISITED ON OCTOBER 7, 1963 BY G. S. SPENCER AND R. H. ENGELKEN, REGION V DIVISION OF COMPLIANCE. THE AEC INSPECTORS WERE ACCOMPANIED BY W. K. CLOUD, C. F. KNUDSON AND V. A. MOORE OF THE U.S. COAST GEOLOGICAL SURVEY, SAN FRANCISCO, CALIFORNIA. THE EXCAVATION FLOOR ELEVATION HAS PROGRESSED TO THE -59 FT. LEVEL WITH THE SCHEDULE CALLING FOR REACHING THE -73 FT ELEVATION BY THE 18TH OF OCTOBER. ALL ON-SITE CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES WHICH HAD TAKEN PLACE ON THE DATE OF VISIT APPEARED TO BE IN ACCORD WITH THE LETTER FROM N. R. SUTHERLAND TO ROBERT LOWENSTEIN DATED JUNE 27, 1963 SETTING FORTH PG&E'S PLANS FOR PREPARATION OF THE EXCAVATION FOR THE PROPOSED BODEGA BAY REACTOR AND REQUESTING CONFIRMATION OF PG&E'S VIEWS CONCERNING THE APPLICATION OF THE COMMISSION'S REGULATIONS 10 CFR 50.10, TO SUCH WORK; THE LETTER OF REPLY FROM THE GENERAL COUNSEL DATED JULY 23, 1963 AND THE CONDITIONS SET FORTH IN SECTIONS 50.10/B OF 10 CFR 50.
