

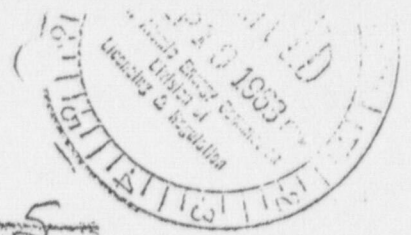

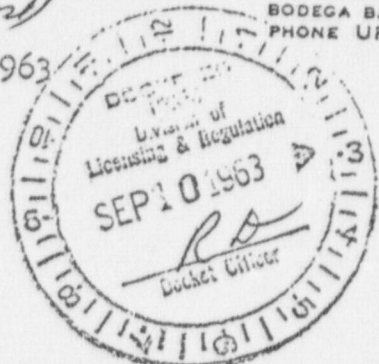

Dear Mr. Seaborg:

Locally there are many conflicting statements about Pacific Gas and Electric Company's continuing investment in its proposed nuclear plant site on Bodega Head, Bodega Bay.

We shall appreciate a statement from you telling us whether or not P.G.&E. has received approval, conditional or otherwise, from any branch or committee of the Atomic Energy Commission. If conditional approval has been given, will you please state the conditions.

P.G.&E. seems positive of final approval by your commission. This is evidenced by the vast amount of money being spent and by its own published statements. We fear its investment here will be used in an effort to secure final approval, and that it will be a consideration at that time.

On the other hand it is our opinion that the investment of our fishing community should be given first consideration. Several hundred commercial fishing vessels working from this port represent a sizeable investment. The annual proceeds from harvesting our natural resources - salmon, crab and other fish and shellfish, - amount to approximately \$1 1/2 million. Already P.G.&E. has destroyed propagation and incubation beds by construction of their unnecessary road that has taken some 40 acres from this small bay.

It is evident that if the nuclear plant is permitted, the "buffer zone" will include the entrance to our harbor. Admittedly any nuclear incident could cause closing of this entrance, which would present great danger to the fishing boats.

We've given just a couple of the concerns of the people of this community, of Sonoma County, and of Northern Californians in general.
