Dear Dr. Seaborg:

While I feel that nuclear generation of electric power is a wonderful accomplishment, I would hope that plant site location could be carried out with proper attention to scenic and safety factors. This, I feel, has not been true in the case of the proposed P.G. & E. reactor at Bodega Head.

Not only do the peninsula and harbor have scenic and recreational value, but the headland is of considerable scientific interest from the viewpoint of ecology. In addition the presence of part of the San Andreas rift zone within $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of the plant violates safety considerations.

I hope that the present site will not be approved by the A.E.C.
