
3. That William D. (Dave) Hollander be added to item 6 (h) as Associate Radiation Safety Officer. His position is that of Metallurgist on the Organizational Chart.

He is a degreed metallurgist and has passed the ASNT Level III test in the radiographic method. His responsibilities include, but are not limited to, maintenance of the Emergency and Operating Procedures, requests for license revisions and renewals, maintaining the records required by the NRC, conducting the quarterly audits of personnel and facilities, assisting the R.S.O. (H. McBride) in the training and testing of personnel, and functioning as the R.S.O. when required by the absence or incapacity of the R.S.O.
