
The purpose of this modification is to extend the period of performance and to add a new clause under Section H. Therefore, the contract is modified at no additional cost to the Government as follows:

1. Section F.2, Performance Period, is deleted and replaced with the following:

"The period of performance of this contract shall be from 9/25/85 through 6/3/89."

2. Section H, add the following new clause as H.10, Publication Requirements:

Except as provided herein, all terms and conditions of the document referenced in Item 9A or 10A, as heretofore changed, remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

Such publication shall focus on advances in science and technology, but not conclusions and/or recommendations which may have regulatory implications. The NRC Project Officer shall make the determination whether the publication of the research results should be pursued. The contractor will be notified by the Contracting Officer (CO) of any requirement to publish research results. Verbal notifications by the CO will be confirmed in writing."
