INSTRUCTIONS TO TELEPHONE OPERATOR CONCERNING  
NUCLEAR PACEMAKERS

1. Accept any collect call with reference to nuclear pacemakers.
2. Any call involving a patient with a nuclear pacemaker requires immediate action to ensure that there is no danger of radiation exposure and recovery of the nuclear pacemaker.
3. Obtain as much information from the caller as is possible including:

Caller's name and where he may be reached.  
Patient's name, status, and where he may be reached.  
Attending Physician (if any) and where he may be reached.

(Information from Patient I.D. Card)  
Patient's Social Security Number  
Date of Implant  
Pacemaker Serial Number

4. Notify immediately:

If neither can be reached, contact physician on duty for the Cardiac Care Unit; inform him that this involves a nuclear pacemaker; and advise him of the information you have and the urgency of the matter.
