Any call involving a patient with a nuclear pacemaker requires immediate action to ensure that there is no danger of radiation exposure and recovery of the nuclear pacemaker. Obtain as much information from the caller as is possible 3. including: Caller's name and where he may be reached. Patient's name, status, and where he may be reached. Attending Physician (if any) and where he may be reached. (Information from Patient I.D. Card) Patient's Social Security Number Date of Implant Pacemaker Serial Number Notify immediately: 4.
