Gentlemen:

This refers to your November 1, 1986 application for a materials license. A check for \$230 accompanied the application in payment of the application fee for a license to receive samples containing byproduct material as specified in fee Category 3P of §170.31 of the enclosed 10 CFR 170.

It is not clear from your application whether you are also applying for authorization to calibrate instruments for other licensees or to calibrate your own instruments only. Please clarify this for us. If you wish to calibrate instruments for other licensees, an additional application fee of \$930 is required as specified in fee Category 3N of §170.31, 10 CFR 170. In addition, your request for authorization to receive samples containing source material is subject to an additional fee of \$350 as specified in fee Category 2G of §170.31. Payment of the appropriate additional fees should be made to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and mailed to the attention of Cheryl Phillips at our Washington, D.C. address.

Your application will be processed by the Region III Licensing staff located at 799 Roosevelt Road, Glen Ellyn, Illinois 60137. The additional fee, however, is required prior to issuance of the license. When submitting the fee(s) and clarifying information, please refer to CONTROL NUMBER 382404.
