Gentlemen:

This is a request for an amendment to our above-referenced license authorizing two modifications to our license conditions.

First, we request a change in our license condition referring to position title required of the Chairmen of the Radioisotope Committees. Currently the Chairmen of the Radioisotope Committees are required to be at least at the Area Supervisor level of management (Reference our License Application, Item 15, Part B, Section III, paragraph 1, pg. 77).

Specifically we request this requirement be removed from our license conditions. Therefore, please remove the statement, "Chairmen must be of an Area Supervisor Management level or above."; and insert, "The appointment to Chairmen of the Radioisotope Committee is subject to authorization by the license amendment approval process through the USNRC given adequate qualifications in training and experience."

Secondly, we request a change in the Radioisotope Committee Chairmen for the Boston Site. The current Chairmen of the Boston Radioisotope Committee is Jeff Neumann. We request a replacement be authorized on our license for Dr. John Hsu as new Chairman of the Boston Radioisotope Committee.

Dr. Hsu has worked for the DuPont, Medical Products Department, Boston Area Site (previously New England Nuclear) for 13 years. A curriculum vitae for Dr. Hsu is attached. He will bring to the committee several years of direct operational experience involving large quantities of radioactive material in the Boston facilities. Dr. Hsu is currently the Section Supervisor of the Boston's Waste Engineering Group and


