Dear Sirs:

As you know, our teletherapy license is due to expire on May 31, 1987. We have enclosed the forms requesting renewal of that license, and a check for \$350 to cover the renewal fee.

We have submitted our renewal without reference to any previously submitted material. The major differences between the current renewal and the previous license are as follows:

- 1) New Radiation Safety Officer and Teletherapy Physicist We recently hired a full-time medical physicist, James W. Israel, who will serve as Radiation Safety Officer and Teletherapy Physicist.
- 2) Changes in Authorized Users We have eliminated users who are no longer active in teletherapy treatment, and added physicians who have recently joined the hospital.
- 3) Renovation of Therapy Department The Radiation Therapy Department has been renovated since the previous license was issued. The survey contained in Item 9 was submitted to your office in July 1986.

We are aware that you prefer that license renewal applications arrive at your office at least 30 days before the expiration of the current license. We were nearly ready to send our application at the end of April when our physicist called Paul Guinn of your office with a question about fees. Mr. Guinn informed Mr. Israel that some of the material we had received in our renewal package was out of date, and Mr. Guinn suggested that we hold our application until he could send us the more current material. Mr. Guinn stated that it would be acceptable for us to have our license renewal application in as late as the day before our current license expires.
