Reference is made to your letter of 26 January 1989 to Mr. R. Aubrey requesting our agreement, as required pursuant to Article XII.D and Article XII.C of the Agreement for Cooperation Bacwaan the Government of the United States of America and the Government of Canada Concerning Civil Uses of Atomic Emergy, as amended, to enrich Canadian source material and to transfer the product to CERCA in France for fuel fabrication.

We understand that the quantity of Canadian uranium to be used as feed is approximately 271 kilograms and have taken note that the product, containing 1 487 gU enriched to 93.3% U235, is ultimately destined for Canada to fuel the McMaster reactor. Appropriate steps have been taken to make the enriched product subject to the Canada/Eurstom Agreement for nuclear cooperation upon transfer to France.

In light of the above information, we hereby agree to the subject requests. FEB
