The route requested in your letter is judged to meet the regulatory requirements in accordance with 10 CFR 73.37 for shipments of spent fuel and is approved. However, in the vicinity of New Concord, Ohio (milemarker (mm) 173) there is a section of I-70 which is currently impassable as a result of a landslide. Ohio State Highway Patrol (OSHP) has made arrangements to detour the spent fuel carrier around this obstruction. The vehicle is to meet OSHP personnel at the New Concord weigh station at approximately 11:00 p.m. At this time Ohio Disaster Services personnel will inspect the vehicle. Upon completion of the inspection a police officer will escort the spent fuel vehicle for the five miles of the detour. In the event your carrier is required to further deviate from the approved route, please call the contact listed on page two of this letter as soon as possible providing the details. Arrangements with law enforcement agencies along the route as required by 10 CFR 73.37(a)(2) have been completed by the NRC staff. Data relating to these arrangements and a copy of the approved route is enclosed. This information is to be incorporated into your shipment plans and provided to your carrier along with instructions regarding its use. Please note that assuring highway safety is the responsibility of the licensee and carrier and our approval is not intended to provide relief in this regard. During seasonal periods when inclement weather with accompanying hazardous road conditions can occur with short notice, the appropriate state police should be contacted with regard to road conditions before a shipment commences. Please note that the notification requirements of 10 CFR 73.37(f) and 73.72 for each shipment still apply. When making a notification to a governor or his designee, it should be very specific especially with regard to notification of series shipments. Written notification must designate exactly how many individual shipments are to be included. a revision of the original notification and an increase or decrease in the number of shipments.
