SUBJECT: FINDINGS OF INSPECTION CONDUCTED AUGUST 18-19, 1987

On September 22, 1987, representatives of Precision Logging and Perforating met with Region IV personnel in Tulsa, Oklahoma, to discuss the apparent violations and corrective actions taken or planned by the licensee as a result of the safety inspection conducted August 18-19, 1987. The attendance list is attached to this Summary. The meeting was held at the request of Region IV.

The NRC presented seven apparent violations of NRC requirements from the recent inspection and reviewed the licensee's inspection history on previous inspections. The licensee's representatives responded to each item relative to their understanding of the violations, but presented no information that would allow deletion or modification of the violations at this time. The licensee described the actions taken or planned to bring the licensed program within full compliance of NRC requirements. The NRC staff explained the NRC enforcement policy and stated that a decision would be made as to the appropriate enforcement action and that the licensee would then be notified.
