

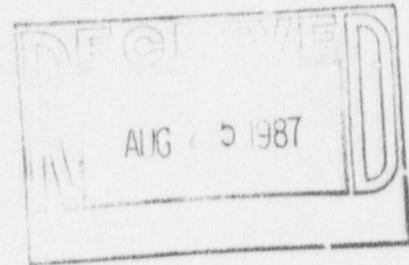

Dear Mr. Everett:

We would like to amend our materials license number 11-16934-01, expiration date July 31, 1992, as follows:

#7. Chemical and/or physical form

- A. Add "Sealed neutron sources (Troxler Dwg. A-102451)"
- B. Add "Sealed sources (Campbell Pacific Nuclear Model CPN-131)"
- C. Add "Sealed sources (Troxler Dwg. A-102112)"

#8. Maximum amount that licensee may possess at any one time under this license.

- B. Change "Not to exceed 2 millicuries per source" to "Not to exceed 10 millicuries per source".

#9. Authorized use

- A. Change "For use in Campbell Pacific Model 503 gauge to measure properties of materials," to "For use in Campbell Pacific Model 503 and MC Series gauges and Troxler Model 3401 and 3401B gauges for moisture/density measurements."
