

In response to your letter (copy attached) dated January 30, 1987, requesting additional information regarding the renewal of By-product Material License No. 43-16713-01, the following information is for your review:

Item 10.4: Personnel Monitoring Equipment.

Personal film badges are used to monitor individuals who may receive or are likely to receive, radiation in excess of 25% of the specified dosage. Type P1 film badges are supplied by R.S. Landover Jr. & Company and are exchanged at intervals of once a month.

It is the policy of Horrocks Engineers, Inc., that any maintenance, cleaning, and/or repair is conducted only by a certified licensed technician. The firm used is Nuclear Testing Services of Salt Lake City, Utah.

Item 10.5: Transportation of Gauges.

The packaging and transportation of the gauges are carried out in accordance of the Utah Department of Transportation regulations.

All shipping is in the factory-manufactured shipping container properly labeled with Radioactive Yellow-II labels.

Vehicular transportation of gauges are in covered vehicles in the trunk or compartmentalized away from drivers. Gauges are kept in the manufacture's shipping container and the source is locked in the safe position, and the container locked in place to prevent theft.
