

Dear Mr. Rouse:

In a letter dated January 27, 1989, SFC transmitted (8) copies of the 1988 Vegetable Monitoring Report, dated January 27, 1989, in accordance with the requirements of License Condition No. 13 to SUB-1010.

In subsequent conversions with Ms. Horne of your staff, we were advised of a number of errors in the presentation of the data given in Attachments 1 and 2 to the report. Specifically, the values given in Attachment 1 were reported as U-Nat when they should have been reported as U-238. In Attachment 2, the radium values were inverted and the value for U-238 was used as the conversion factor rather than U-Nat. The errors have been corrected.

Rather than replace individual pages, we are re-issuing the entire report. Enclosed with this letter are (8) copies of the 1988 Vegetable Monitoring Report, dated March 2, 1989 (Revised). You are requested to discard all copies received of the previous report.
