SUBJECT: EXEMPTION UNDER §170.11(b)(1), 10 CFR 170, FOR
SPECIFIC LICENSES ISSUED UNDER REVISED 10 CFR
PART 35 TO REPLACE FORMER IN-VIVO GENERAL LICENSES

Revised 10 CFR Part 35, which went into effect April 1, 1987, eliminated the in-vivo general license provisions contained in §35.31 of the previous Part 35. In order to incorporate the former general licenses into NRC's filing system, specific licenses were issued to the former general licensees who responded affirmatively to an NRC notice that asked if they wanted to continue to have an NRC license that would be limited to the clinical procedures authorized by the former general licenses. A pre-printed application was provided for the former general licensees' use in responding to the notice. Eighty-nine new specific licenses were issued in response to the applications received from the former general licensees.

Since the former general licenses were not subject to fees, and since no NRC technical review time was required to issue the new specific licenses, the Commission hereby grants an exemption from the fees contained in 10 CFR 170 for the eighty-nine specific licenses on the attached list which replaced the former in-vivo general licenses. This exemption applies only to the materials and uses authorized under the in-vivo general license provisions of the previous §35.31. Future applications from the former general licensees for amendments to the new specific licenses or for other licensing actions will be subject to the license fees specified in 10 CFR 170.
