8	COMMISSIONER CARR: No.
9	CHAIRMAN ZECH: If not, Mr. Secretary, please

11	MR. BATES: Mr. Chairman, the first item SECY 87-250
12	requires a vote to hold on less than one weeks notice.
13	CHAIRMAN ZECH: Aye.
14	COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.
15	COMMISSIONER CARR: Aye.
16	MR. BATES: Subject to SECY 87-250, application for a
17	stay of Commission decision UCLI 87-9 regarding the importation
18	of South African uranium into the United States. The
19	Commission is being asked to respond to a request from the
20	petitioners for a stay of the Commission's September 21st, 1987
21	order which held that one importation of forms of uranium other
22	than uranium ore and uranium oxide is not barred by the Anti-
23	Apartheid Act.
24	And two, that importation of South African uranium
25	ore and uranium oxide which is transformed into uranium

1	hexaflour or other substantially transformed uranium compounds
2	before importation is not barred by the Act.
3	All Commissioners have approved an order which we
4	circulated to you a little earlier this morning which denies
5	the requested stay.
6	Will you affirm your votes, please.
7	CHAIRMAN ZECH: Aye.
8	COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.
9	COMMISSIONER CARR: Aye.
10	MR. BATES: The second item is SECY 87-263 in the
11	matter of Pacific Gas and Electric Company; the Commission is
12	being asked to respond to an October 21st, 1987 request from
13	the Sierra Club seeking a Commission stay of decisions by the
14	Atomic Safety and Licensing Board which authorize the issuance
15	of operating license amendments permitting the installation of
16	high density racks and the spent fuel storage pools at Diablo
17	Canyon units one and two.
18	Chairman Zech and Commissioners Bernthal, Carr and
19	Roberts approved an order denying the requested stays;
20	Commissioner Rogers was unavailable to participate.
21	Would you affirm your votes, please.
22	CHAIRMAN ZECH: Aye.
23	COMMISSIONER BERNTHAL: Aye.
24	COMMISSIONER CARR: Aye.
25	CHAIRMAN ZECH: Anything else to come before us?

MR. BATES: That's all. CHAIRMAN ZECH: If not we stand adjourned. [Whereupon, at 11:06 a.m. the meeting was adjourned.] . 19
