Gentlemen:

Please find enclosed "LILCO's Motion for Summary Disposition of Contention 25.C (Role Conflict of School Bus Drivers)," dated October 22, 1987.

The Appeal Board, in ALAB-832, ordered this Board to reconsider its finding in LBP-85-12 (the "PID") on the narrow issue of whether there is reasonable assurance that school bus drivers would do their jobs in the event of a radiological emergency at Shoreham because of "role conflict." A related issue not considered by the Appeal Board in this remand is whether there will be enough buses to effect a one-wave evacuation of all public schools within the ten-mile EPZ. In the PID, this Board found no reasonable assurance that there would be sufficient buses to evacuate all schoolchildren.

In this summary disposition motion LILCO commits to evacuate all public schools within the EPZ in a single wave and to provide additional school bus drivers where needed. LILCO does not make any commitment in this motion as to the availability of


