This letter supplements the information contained in my letter to you of September 22, 1987. (1000-87-2119)

- o We will not return any member of the "B" shift crew to licensed duties without specific approval of the NRC.
- o We will submit a copy of the final results of Mr. Edwin H. Stier's investigation of this incident to the NRC, when it is complete.
- o Recent discussions that I have had with Mr. Stier show that his continued investigation has not identified anything that would change the basic findings of his preliminary report and in particular his conclusion that "The evidence we have obtained to date also establishes that when management personnel above the level of "B" shift learned of the conduct that had occurred on "B" shift, they acted promptly to investigate and report the circumstances to their superiors and to the NRC."
