This is to acknowledge receipt of your letters NMM-DLC-87-175 dated August 7, 1987 and NMM-CFS-87-057, with attachment, dated August 13, 1987 dealing with the receipt of cylinders and corresponding samples of low enriched UF₆ from the U.S.S.R. Other documents dealing with the subject is your letter LA87-36 with attachment dated June 17, 1987 and our response, with new License Condition 4.1, to you dated July 8, 1987.

The methods described in your above referenced letters number 175 and 057 are appropriate based on a unique situation dictated by circumstances beyond your control. Accordingly, we have no problem with the solution contained in your August 13, 1987 letter.

We have determined that your letter dated August 7, 1987 and the attachment to your letter dated August 13, 1987 contain information of the type specified in 10 CFR 2.790(d). Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(d)(1), such information is deemed to be commercial or financial within the meaning of 10 CFR 9.5(a)(4) and shall be withheld from public disclosure unless subject to the provisions of 10 CFR 9.12.
