
Based on discussions with the NRC Staff, Houston Lighting & Power Company (HL&P) is submitting the attached (A) description of Security related activities which are proposed to be ongoing after initial fuel loading of Unit 1 at South Texas Project Electric Generating Station (STPEGS). HL&P has taken appropriate compensatory measures as described in the attached revisions to the Physical Security Plan (Attachment B) and Training & Qualification Plan (Attachment C). Additional program changes are identified in Attachments B and C which are necessary based on NRC inspection activities currently in progress at STPEGS.

Also included as Attachment D is Revision 6 of the STPEGS Safeguards Contingency Plan. This revision is in response to NRC comments.

The enclosures contain material of a sensitive nature and should be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR73.21. As the enclosed material replaces all previous revisions to these pages, you are requested to dispose of the superseded pages from the STPEGS Physical Security Plan, and Security Personnel Training and Qualification Plan.
