On March 2, 1989, J. Persensky and Ann Ramey-Smith from the Human Factors Branch (RES) and I visited the Amersham Corporation facility in Burlington, Massachusetts. The purpose of our visit was to gain background information o industrial radiography equipment, procedures, and training. Persons contacte were William McDaniel, Corporate Manufacturing Manager, and Cathleen Roughan, Radiation Safety Officer.

The majority of our visit was spent with Mrs. Roughan who described the proce of radiography and the equipment used in that process. Discussion included the qualifications and training of radiographers. Mrs. Roughan also provided hands-on access to classroom demonstrator equipment and the opportunity to se a broad range of radiography equipment which had been returned for maintenant or disposal.
