
I would like to take this opportunity to relay to you the enclosed correspondence sent to me by Robert J. Perkins.


Re: NRC Rule Changes

Dear Sir

I wish to express my support of the proposal by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission to change its rules so that licensing of a nuclear plant can go forward even though a state or local community refuses to participate in the emergency planning process.

I do not believe that a state governor should have Veto power over new generating stations regardless of where they are constructed. The Regulatory Commission should decide these issues and be subject to court challenge by those who might be in disagreement.
