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Fitness For Duty Program Performance Data Report

During the reporting period, January 1 through June 30, 1998, the Trojan Nuclear Plant Security Department continued to operate under the Trojan Nuclear Plant Security Plan (Defueled Condition). The Security Plan contains a commitment to 10 CFR 26 for unescorted access to the Trojan Protected Area.

Effectiveness Summary

No positive drug or alcohol tests occurred during this reporting period.

During this reporting period the Trojan Nuclear Plant Fitness For Duty Program staffing level remained at two personnel.

Events Reported

No reportable events occurred during this reporting period.

Statistical Summary

During the reporting period, the Fitness For Duty Program conducted 136 pre-access drug and alcohol tests, 102 random drug and alcohol tests, 7 follow-up drug and alcohol tests, 1 return to work drug and alcohol test, and 2 reasonable suspicion drug and alcohol tests. PGE's overall positive rate for the random screening program was 0.0 percent (0 percent for PGE employees and 0 percent for contract personnel). PGE's overall positive rate for pre-access testing was 0 percent (0 percent for PGE employees and 0 percent for contract personnel). The positive rate for all screenings during the period January through June 1998 is 0.6 percent.

The Trojan Nuclear P!ant average population during the reporting period was 362. The total number of random tests during this period was 102. At the end of the reporting period, PGE had randomly screened 28 percent of the average plant population granted protected area unescorted access. During this period 136 pre-access tests were completed.
