The focus of GL 97-05 was to verify that licensee steam generator tube inspection practices were consistent with existing regulatory and plant licensing basis.

Your March 13, 1998, response to GL 97-05 included a description and your technical basis for inspection techniques used to size the depth of steam generator tube degradation at V. C. Summer. We reviewed your response and did not identify any concerns with your inspection techniques that would indicate that you were not in compliance with Summer's current licensing basis.
