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
## COMMISSION VOTING RECORD

### COMMENT RESOLUTION

In their vote sheets, Chairman Jackson and Commissioner McGaffigan approved the staff's recommendation and provided some additional comments. Commissioner Diaz approved the waiver for the work with Lithuania (\$0.65 million and .3 FTE) but disapproved the waiver for the work on the existing Central and Eastern Europe (CEE) interagency agreement with AID (\$0.215 million and a small fraction of the Lithuanian FTE). Subsequently, the comments of the Commission were incorporated into the guidance to staff as reflected in the SRM issued on August 25, 1998.
