Performance Testing of Relief and Safety Valves
NUREG-0737, Item II.D.1

By letter dated June 17, 1987, Terence Chan of your staff requested that Portland General Electric (PGE) provide additional information regarding the testing of relief and safety valves for the Trojan Nuclear Plant. It was requested that this information be provided within 45 days from receipt of the letter, or a schedule to provide this information be submitted within 15 days.

Due to activities associated with the current refueling outage, the 15-day response time for provision of a schedule was inadvertently overlooked. PGE has reviewed your request and determined that additional time will be required to adequately address each item. Accordingly, we plan to issue a detailed response to the five (5) items listed in the enclosure to your June 17, 1987 letter by October 30, 1987.
