Dear Dr. Glenn:

I am enclosing for your evaluation a Health and Safety Review of our Model 8800 Density Gauge. By this letter I am also applying for Materials Licenses to manufacture and distribute this gauge under a general license.

The Model 8800 is similar to the Model 8600 which was approved in June (Registry No. NR-469-D-101-G). The important differences concern the exterior radiation level and the automatic source shutter mechanism. I believe the design of this gauge is such that it can be approved for general licensee installation, persuant to 10 CFR Section 32.51 (c). The information submitted in the Health and Safety review indicates that any user, even one unfamiliar with radiation safety procedures, would be unitkely to receive an excess of 10% of the doses listed in Lection 20.101 while handling, installing, testing or storing the device. I thereby request that general licensees be permitted to install the Model 8800 Density Gauge.
