Gentlemen:

This refers to your conversation with Messrs. D. G. Wiedeman and J. Mullauer of my staff on August 19, 1987, regarding the incident that occurred at your Lima, Ohio Facility on August 6, 1987.

Based on that conversation, it is our understanding that the following actions will be taken:

- 1. Within the next six (6) months, each Branch RSO will perform unannounced audits of all field sites at each of your 24 NRC authorized locations of use.
- You will submit the results and the corrective actions of these audits to the NRC Region III office.
- After the completion of the field audits, you will submit an amendment to your license to include unannounced field audits in your semi-annual branch office audit procedures.
- 4. While the gauge is being transported or is in use at a field site, the key to the device will be removed from the carrying case and maintained in the possession of the responsible operator.
- 5. You will immediately instruct each user of nuclear gauges in the proper procedures for source rod lock and key control and proper chain and lock procedures while transporting nuclear gauges.
