Enclosed in duplicate is our application for renewal of Materials License 47-09576-01 which expires March 31, 1987.

We have chosen to submit the application in its entirety rather than making reference to previous submittals, except that we have not re-submitted the credentials of those physicians already listed on the license. We believe that this simplifies our compliance with the conditions of the license since it minimizes the number of documents in which commitments are made.

As indicated in the current application, we want to retain those physicians previously listed on the license and to retain M. Douglass Allan, M.S. as our Radiation Safety Officer. We want to add Doctors Paul V. Akers, Dennis M. Burton, and Richard E. McWhorter as specified. They meet the requirements of 10 CFR 35 as amended in October, 1986.

We have reviewed extensively the new requirements of 10 CFR 35 and have incorporated them in our practices and procedures. A number of changes in our supporting documents are in response to the changes in 10 CFR 35. We trust that our application is complete and look forward to the renewal of our license.
