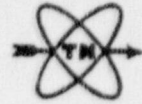

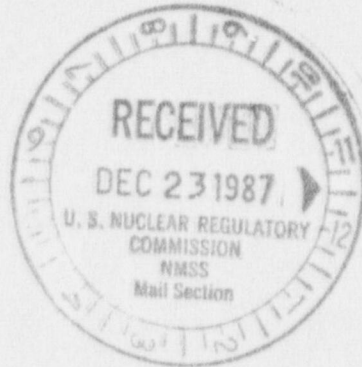

Norfolk, VA (via NIT) to Savannah River Plant

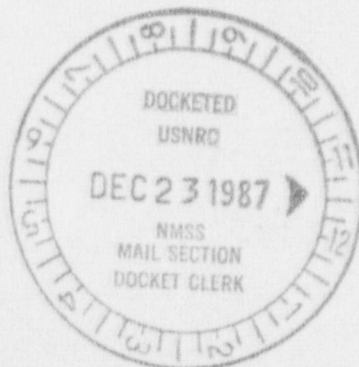
The requested route has no changes from that which was utilized in 1987.

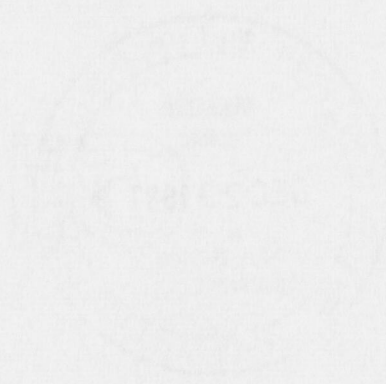
