

COMMENT RESOLUTION

In their vote sheets, Chairman Jackson and Commissioner McGaffigan approved the staff's recommendation to pursue Option 1. Commissioner Diaz disapproved Option 1 and preferred that the NRC discontinue efforts to independently assess a licensee's safety conscious work environment. Subsequently, the comments of the Commission were incorporated into the guidance to staff as reflected in the SRM issued on September 1, 1998.
