On January 8, 1963, Mr. Welchel of PG&E called to inquire about scheduling of activities leading to the issuance of a construction permit on Bodega plant. He stated he would not presume that my remarks would indicate a commitment on a part of the Staff to a schedule that he might propose.

He was advised that March was the time for the next regular ACRS meeting after the one being held at the later part of this month, and that the Bodega case would probably be discussed with the committee at that time. There was also discussion of the time required after ACRS approval for preparation for public hearing and for subsequent action.

Mr. Welchel inquired about a time which we would consider appropriate for technical discussion between the Staff and PG&E. He was advised it was too early to decide on the date for such a meeting, but that we would contact him as soon as it appeared reasonable to suggest a meeting date.
