This replies to your letter of September 1, 1963, addressed to President Kennedy in which you expressed concern with respect to the proposed construction of a nuclear power reactor at Bodega Bay, Galifornia.

At the Commission's request, the U. S. Geological Survey has been conducting a thorough field study of the geology of Bodega Bay since early May. In addition, expert consultants have been retained to assist the AEC Regulatory Staff in evaluating Pacific Cas & Electric Company's explication with respect to the seismology of the area and structural design of the proposed plant. Final action on the Pacific Cas & Electric Company application will not be taken until the report by the U. S. Geological Survey has been received and evaluated. Further, a construction permit will not be issued unless the Commission, following a public hearing and a decision by the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board and consideration of all factors bearing upon safety is convinced that the facility can be constructed and operated at the proposed location without undue risk to the health and safety of the public.

Enclosed is a pauphlet which describes the procedures relating to the licensing of power reactors by the Atomic Energy Commission. The public will be given thirty days notice of the date of the public hearing to be held in Sants Hose in this matter through a notice published in the Federal Register. In addition, a public announcement will be issued.

We feel confident that these procedures and their provision for public bearing will emable all interested persons to acquaint themselves with the details of Facific Gas & Electric Company's proposal and will assure thorough consideration of all aspects of the proposed plant bearing upon the question of all aspects of the proposed and operated at the proposed site without undue risk to the health and safety of the public.
