NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR CONSTRUCTION PERMIT AND UTILIZATION FACILITY LICENSE

PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY

Please take notice that Pacific Gas and Electric Company, 245 Market Street, San Francisco 6, California, pursuant to Section 104b of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, has submitted an application, dated December 28, 1962, for a license to construct and operate at Bodega Bay Atomic Park, California, a boiling water nuclear reactor with a rated thermal output of 1008 megawatts and an electrical output of 325 megawatts. The site proposed for construction of the nuclear facility consists of 225 acres of land located on Bodega Head, Sonoma County, on the shore of the Pacific Ocean and approximately 50 miles northwest of the City of San Francisco. The earliest estimated date for completion of the facility is January 1, 1966 and the latest estimated date for its completion is June 1, 1967.
