Dear Mr. & Mrs. Michaels:

This replies to your letter of August 7, 1963 addressed to Chairman Seaborg in which you urged that a public hearing in the matter of the nuclear reactor proposed for construction at Bodega Head, California be held at an early date.

Enclosed is a pamphlet which describes the procedures relating to the licensing of power reactors by the Atomic Energy Commission. At the Commission's request, the U. S. Geological Survey early in May, began a study of the geology of Bodega Head. When the report on that study has been received from the U. S. Geological Survey, we will be in a better position to complete our analysis of the suitability of the Bodega Head site and to set a date for public hearing on the company's application. The public will be given thirty days notice of the date of the hearing, which will be held in Santa Rosa, through a notice published in the Federal Register. In addition, a public announcement will be issued.
