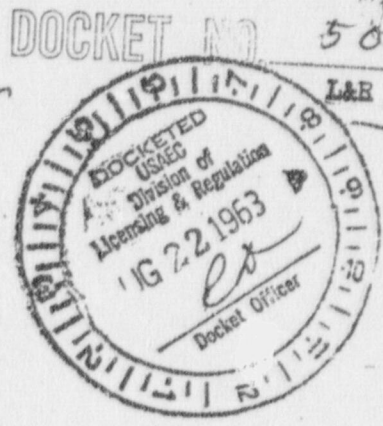

The building of the atomic reactor is progress. An economical location based on sound engineering.

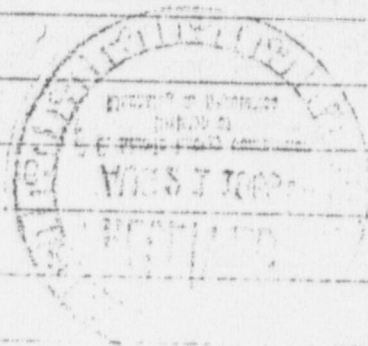
