GA Technologies hereby makes application, pursuant to 10 CFR 110, to renew the subject license for an additional term of two years. The present expiration date is June 30, 1987; the proposed new expiration date is June 30, 1989. 1991*

This amendment is necessary in anticipation of an order for seven additional fuel elements for the TRIGA reactor at Musashi Institute of Technology. It is also requested that the quantity of Uranium-235 be increased as follows:

from: 3.184 kilograms Uranium-235 contained in 16.000 kilograms uranium, enriched to 19.9 w/o maximum

to: 3.457 kilograms Uranium-235 contained in 17.38 kilograms uranium, enriched to 19.9 w/o maximum
