Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) has provided its responses to the FEMA Post Exercise Assessment for the June 7-9, 1988 Exercise and the FEMA Regional Assistance Committee comments on Revision 10 of the offsite plan. The responses are enclosed.

In accordance with the April 9, 1985 NRC/FEMA Memorandum of Understanding, we request that FEMA review LILCO's responses to the two FEMA reports. Please advise us as to whether LILCO's responses adequately address the areas requiring corrective action as identified during the exercise and the outstanding plan inadequacies. LILCO has committed to incorporate the proposed plan changes into the next plan revision, currently scheduled for May 1989.
