

RE: Upcoming Sequoyah Facility "Open House"

Dear Mr. Hall:

As was discussed during the NRC Assessment Team vibit the week of July 10, 1989, Sequoyah Fuels Corporation (SFC) is planning an "Open House" at its Sequoyah Facility Saturday, August 5, 1989. Persons invited include SFC employees and their families, neighbors, friends, and local dignitaries.

All chemical process systems will be shut down during the "Open House." Visitors will be t ken on escorted tours to include limited portions of the Restricted Area. The tour route has been thoroughly cleaned and surveyed, and barricades will be installed to carefully define the route. Visitors will be allowed access to these limited areas without protective clothing. Each group's exposure will be recorded using a single beta-gamma dosimeter. Each visitor will be individually "frisked" by Health and Safety personnel upon exiting the Restricted Area.

Air sampling and ventilation systems will be in operation, and additional air samplers will be placed along the tour route. EMT/First Aid personnel will be on site.
