Thank you for your response of May 12, 1989, to our Notice of Violation issued on January 20, 1989, concerning activities conducted under NRC License No. 52-21003-01. We have evaluated your response and found that it meets the requirements of 10 CFR 2.201. We will examine the implementation of your corrective actions during future inspections.

With regard to Violation D.1, the documents you submitted do comply with U.S. DOT requirements in 49 CFR 177.817(a). We accept your position that they were carried in the logging truck and will therefore delete the violation from our records. You should ensure that for future NRC inspections, all required documents and records must be available for review by the inspector while onsite during the inspection. You should also be aware of the DOT Regulation 49 CFR 177.817(e)(2) that requires the driver to store the shipping papers within his immediate reach while driving and either readily visible to a person entering the driver's compartment or in a holder which is mounted to the inside of the door on the driver's side of the logging truck.

We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.
